Introduction

This booklet provides a guide of funding opportunities for cultural collaborations between the Kingdom of the Netherlands* and the Kingdom of Belgium, offered by the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Belgium and DutchCulture, the Dutch platform for international cultural cooperation.

The main objective of this booklet is to inform both countries' cultural sectors on funding bodies and programmes that support the cultural collaboration between the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Belgium. The overview focuses on funding for projects taking place in Belgium. Both, projects carried out by makers based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands and collaborations between two cultural partners (makers/organisations) from the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Belgium, are eligible.

Please note that this funding guide is based on DutchCulture's **Digital Mobility Funding Guide**, helping to explore funding opportunities for international projects, such as exhibitions, tours, residencies, festival participation, or collaborations abroad. The digital mobility funding guide also includes options for further education abroad, like summer courses or masterclasses. For more information, please scan the QR code below.



*The Kingdom of the Netherlands refers to the Netherlands as well as the Caribbean part, namely Aruba, Bonaire, Curaçao, Sint Eustatius, Sint Maarten and Saba. Oftentimes, more budget than indicated in this overview is available for cultural collaboration between the Caribbean part and Belgium, since for example travel costs are higher. Creative Industries Fund NL: Internationalization of the Design Sector Grant Scheme

For projects in the fields of design, architecture, digital culture, and crossovers, focusing on international research and collaboration with activities primarily taking place abroad (e.g. in Belgium), with one or more international partner(s)

Design, architecture, digital culture and crossovers

Who can apply

Makers, design agencies, cultural institutions or organisations based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what

The grant can be used for research, collaboration and project costs.

How much

A maximum of 50.000 euros

Creative Industries Fund NL: International Vouchers

For professionals in the fields of design, architecture and/or digital culture based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands, who have been invited by a Belgian party to give a presentation, lecture or workshop

Sector

Who can apply

Professionals, cultural institutions, organizations and collectives based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what

The grant can be used for hourly fees, travel expenses, accommodation expenses and other costs necessary for the applicant to carry out the foreign activity.

How much

A maximum of 1.500 euros

Sector

Heritage (both tangible and intangible)

Who can apply

Individual heritage professionals based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands and professionals working at heritage organisations within the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what

The travel scheme can be used for travel and accommodation costs related to a journey or visit to strengthen one's network or exchange knowledge in the field of heritage.

How much

A voucher between 350 and 1.000 euros

DutchCulture: Europe + Heritage

General Support Scheme

To promote the establishment of contacts with the European (e.g. Belgian) heritage sector and the exchange of knowledge between the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the rest of Europe (e.g. Belgium)

Heritage professionals and heritage organisations based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

Dutch Foundation for Literature: Travel Costs

A subsidy for the costs of promotional activities of recently translated works of Dutch, Frisian, Papiamentu or Papiamentu language authors abroad

Dutch Foundation for Literature: Translation Costs

For financial support for the publication in translation of a work of high literary quality originally written in the Dutch or Frisian language, such as fiction, graphic novels, poetry, children's literature and classic works

The grant can be used for translation and project costs.

A maximum of 10.000 euros

Dutch Foundation for Literature, Taalunie, Flanders Literature: Subsidy for Literary Exchange

Intended to encourage cooperations between Dutch-speaking regions (including Flanders, Surinam, the Netherlands, Aruba, Bonaire, Curaçao, Saba, Sint Eustatius and Sint Maarten) and to increase those regions' knowledge of each other's literary culture

Sector

Literature

Who can apply

Literary organisations and creators from the above-mentioned Dutch-speaking regions

For what

The grant can be used for costs connected to meetings and workshops, and project costs.

How much

A maximum of 2.500 euros for individuals

A maximum of 10.000 euros for organisations

Upcoming deadlines

For organisations, there are usually two deadlines per year, check the website for more information. Makers can apply every first day of the month.

A grant for cultural projects set up/carried out by cultural organisations in Belgium that want to provide a platform to makers/organisations/artists based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands, thereby giving audiences in Belgium access to Dutch culture, can apply for financial support from the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Belgium

Sector

All (with a focus on performing arts, visual arts, creative industries and digital culture)

Who can apply

Project partner/cultural institution in Belgium

For what

The grant can be used for travel, accommodation, communication, art transport and production costs directly associated with the presentation of the project in Belgium.

How much

A maximum of 5.000 euros

Euregio Scheldemond: Scheldemondfonds

Euregio Scheldemond is the cross-border partnership between the provinces of East Flanders, West Flanders and Zeeland. The fund supports small-scale projects in various fields such as education, tourism, culture and heritage.

Municipalities, associations, organisations, foundations, schools, etc. based in East Flanders, West Flanders and/or Zeeland

For what

The grant can be used for project costs.

How much

100% of the (small-scale) project costs

European Commission: Culture Moves Europe Individual Mobility Action

For artists and cultural professionals to carry out a project with a partner of their choice in a Creative Europe country (e.g. Belgium and the Kingdom of the Netherlands). The goal is to explore, create, learn and connect.

Sector

Music, literature, architecture, cultural heritage, design and fashion design, visual arts and performing arts

Who can apply

Artists/cultural professionals who are based in Belgium or the Kingdom of the Netherlands and who want to travel to another Creative Europe country, or to a partner to collaborate with on a project

For what

The grant can be used for travel and subsistence costs and offers additional top-ups based on the grantees' individual situation. For an individual, the grant can last 7 to 60 days, whereas groups of up to 5 people can make use of the grant for 7 to 21 days.

How much

- » A maximum of 350 euros for a travel distance under 5000km
- » A maximum of 700 euros for a travel distance above 5000km
- » A maximum of 75 euros for daily allowance
- » Possible top-ups: green mobility, family and disability

Foundation Iona: Project Support

The Iona Foundation is inspired by anthroposophy and art. It operates at the intersection of value creation and society, supporting various initiatives—including (international) art projects—that aim for development and renewal on social, cultural, and spiritual levels.

Galleries can receive a grant for supporting presentations by living visual artists based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands at a foreign (e.g. Belgian) art fair.

Galleries who participate in an art fair outside of the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what

The grant can be used for the stand rental.

In case of special presentations in separate sections, the grant can be used for transport, travel and accommodation costs and the costs of producing new work.

How much

The maximum grant depends on the percentage of work in the presentation by visual artists from the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the cost of the stand rental.

Visual artists and curators based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands or Belgian art institutions

For what

The grant can be used for costs for producing new work, travel and accommodation costs, and other related costs such as insurance, production and/or translation costs.

How much

- Travel costs for a single trip
- A maximum of 1.000 euros per person towards lodging
- Transport and insurance expenses
- A maximum of 50% of the production costs of new (site-specific) work commissioned by the non-Dutch art institution
- A maximum of 25% of costs of the publication associated with the presentation
- A maximum of 50% of the translation costs of subtitling a film

Mondriaan Fund: Voucher Artist with Child

For visual artists from the Kingdom of the Netherlands with the responsibility of caring for a child who is not yet of compulsory school age

Additional childcare and/or additional travel and accommodation costs for childcare that arise as a direct result of a multi-day activity within a defined period, such as a residency period or construction phase of an exhibition

Mondriaan Fund: Voucher International

The grant can be used for travel and accommodation costs.

How much

A maximum of 2.500 euros

Netherlands Film Fund: Minority Co-Productions VAF

Aimed at enhancing ties between the film industries and producers of Flanders and the Kingdom of the Netherlands, funded by The Flemish Audiovisual Fund (VAF) and the Netherlands Film Fund

The grant can be used for documentary and feature film production costs.

Feature film: a maximum of 200.000 euros

To stimulate film productions and strengthen the international competitive position of the film industry from the Kingdom of the Netherlands, eligible for Belgian projects as well

The grant can be used for documentary and feature film production costs.

How much

35% of the Dutch production costs

For directors, producers, leading actors or screenwriters from the Kingdom of the Netherlands, who are invited to attend the screening of their film at festivals abroad

Sector

Directors, actors, screenwriters or producers based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands, visiting:

- Brussels Cartoon and Animation Film Festival - Anima
- Leuven International Documentary Film Festival - Docville

For what

The grant can be used for travel costs.

How much

2/3 of the ticket price + sustainability bonus up to 100 euros

Performing Arts Fund NL: Grant for Dutch Presentations Abroad (fast-lane)

The subsidy is mainly intended for relatively simple projects with a short preparation time and therefore has an expedited procedure.

Bands, ensembles, foundations, associations, record labels, big bands, singers, songwriters, DJs, composers, playwrights, librettists and choreographers based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what

The grant can be used for travel, transportation and visa costs.

A maximum of 6.000 euros

Performing Arts Fund NL: Grant for Dutch Presentations Abroad

Foreign (e.g. Belgian) parties can apply for support to programme performances or concerts by companies, ensembles or performers based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands.

Who can apply

Belgian venues or festivals with an international programme

For what

Travel and accommodation costs for the performance(s) or concert(s) concerned, and an additional contribution towards the costs of fringe programming (e.g. workshops, masterclasses, lectures) can be awarded where applicable.

How much

The grant amount is determined on the basis of travel and transport costs for the performance(s) or concert(s) concerned. An additional contribution towards the costs of fringe programming (e.g. workshops, masterclasses, lectures) can be awarded where applicable.

Performing Arts Fund NL: International Co-Productions

To facilitate international co-productions and to contribute to the internationalisation and professionalisation of the performing arts sector of the Kingdom of the Netherlands

Producing organisations (music theatre, theatre, dance company or ensemble) or festivals based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands that engage in a collaboration with a professional organisation abroad, in order to jointly develop and produce a performance or concert

A maximum of 75.000 euros
