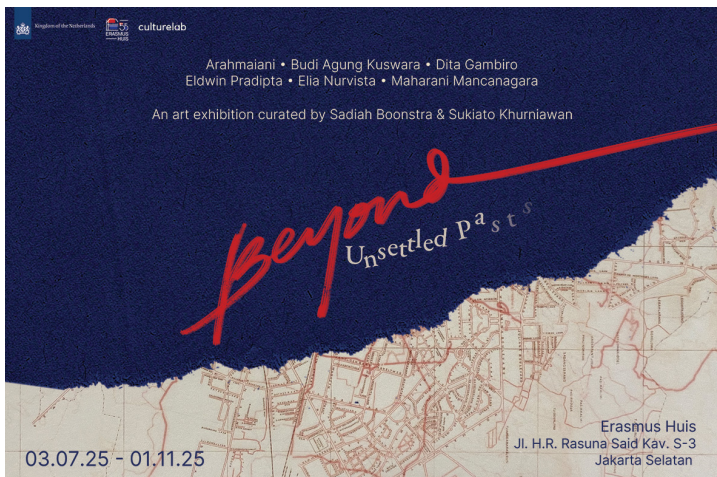

The exhibition features six Indonesian contemporary artists who reflect on how Dutch colonialism still shapes life in Indonesia today. The works explore issues like environmental damage caused by extractive mindsets, social structures rooted in colonial systems, and racial class divisions that continue to affect communities. The artists challenge colonial narratives and imagine a decolonial future by highlighting local traditions, community resilience, and forgotten stories.

Born in Amsterdam with Indonesian roots, Chagall is a multidisciplinary artist merging music and technology to create immersive performances. She pioneered motion capture technology for real-time sound and visual control, blending storytelling, vocals, and digital artistry. Her project “Unlocked” features B.A.B.Y., a reactive light installation fully integrated into the performance. For her Indonesian tour, she’s collaborating with local designers on “Bamboo B.A.B.Y.,” blending futuristic concepts with traditional materials.
