The exhibition explores the everyday moments in which we use, value and eventually discard plastic products. It focuses on the act of throwing something away as a choice that shapes the entire system around us. It invites you to see disposal as an act of passing on. Every piece of plastic that is properly separated keeps value in motion, moving towards a cleaner city, a fairer chain and a future in which throwing something away becomes the beginning of value, not the end. The exhibition is part of the Co/Lab program, a collaboration between Dutch Design Foundation, Wahu, Dutch Embassy and Erasmus Huis.

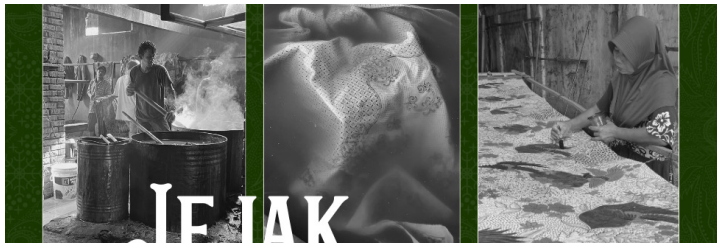


JEJAK BATIK: BECAUSE EVERY LINE OF BATIK CARRIES A TRACE

The exhibition showcases 15 photographic portraits of Dutch Muslims who have gone on pilgrimage by performing the Umrah or Hajj. It explores their spiritual journeys, personal reflections, and the impact this journey has on their daily lives. These personal stories show how the pilgrimage is not only a religious journey but also a source of inner strength, reflection, and connection. Ebru Aydin is a Turkish-Dutch sociologist and photographer whose work focuses on themes such as identity, migration, and the position of Muslims in society.
